Limassol



Limassol is a city on the southern <u>coast</u> of <u>Cyprus</u> and capital of the <u>district with the same name</u>. Limassol is the second largest <u>urban area</u> in Cyprus after <u>Nicosia</u>, with an urban population of 183,658 and a metropolitan population of 239,842.

Limassol has been ranked by <u>TripAdvisor</u> as the 3rd up-and-coming destination in the world, in its *Top 10 Traveler's Choice Destinations on the Rise*. The city is also ranked 89th worldwide in Mercer's Quality of Living Survey (2017).

In the 2020 ranking published by the <u>Globalization and World Cities Research</u> <u>Network</u>, Limassol was classified as a "Gamma -" <u>global city</u>.

Limassol was built between two ancient Greek cities, Amathus and Kourion, and during <u>Byzantine</u> rule it was known as Neapolis (new town). Limassol's historical center is located around its medieval <u>Limassol Castle</u> and the Old Port. Today the city spreads along the <u>Mediterranean</u> coast and has extended much farther than the castle and port, with its suburbs stretching along the coast to Amathus. To the west of the city, is the <u>Akrotiri Area</u> of the <u>British Overseas Territory</u> of <u>Akrotiri and</u>



CERTIFIED FACE MASKS

The use of Certified Masks of FFP2 type or equivalents (N95 (United States), KN95 (China), P2 (Australia/New Zealand), Korea 1st class (Korea), DS2 (Japan)) within the specifications for use is always mandatory in the venue, with the exceptions for athletes that are detailed herein.

Once an athlete enters the venue grounds the athletes must always wear Certified Masks except while warming up, training, and competing in the designated areas/tatamis, respectively. This also means the Certified Mask shall be worn in transit between the Warmup and Competition Areas.

Special Permission countries in the Grey Categories for Referees/ Supporting personnel, participating in professional sport activities and for Athletic. This does not apply for green, orange or red.

- a. Create an account at https://cyprusflightpass.gov.cy/en/special-permission-request
- b. Requests for the granting of a special permit may be submitted through the e-platform within 14 days prior to the expected travel date and the approval granted shall be valid for a month since the date of issue.
- c. Upon the granting of the special permit a unique number will be sent exclusively connected to the passenger's identity card number or passport number.
 - i. The passenger would then be able to use the **unique number** in filling out his/her application for acquiring a **CyprusFlightPass**, by writing it down in the required space as special permit number.
 - ii. II. The passenger must also send the **unique number** to the **Cyprus Karate**Federation at <u>cypruskaratefederation@gmail.com</u>, so they can facilitate the process with the ministries.

If health conditions permit it, there will be commercial stands selling official products, equipment and other merchandising with official branding.

Miscellaneous

Alcohol

The legal drinking age in Cyprus is 18. Drivers should exercise due care over the amount of alcohol consumed. The legal limit in breath is 22 micrograms of alcohol per 100 milliliters of breath. The legal limit in blood is 50 milligrams of alcohol per 100 millilitres of blood.

Tobacco

If you are under 17 years old you are not entitled to a duty free allowance for tobacco.

Currency and Exchange

The currency of Cyprus is the Euro - €, which is divided into 100 cents. Notes and coins currently in circulation are as follows: Banknotes: €5, €10, €20, €50, €100, €200, €500. There are coins in denominations of €2, €1, 50 cent, 20 cent, 10 cent, 5 cent, 2 cent and 1 cent. There are 100 cents to €1. Business Hours

Generally, shops will open between 07:00 - 21:00 on Monday - Saturday, but this can vary an hour or two either way, depending on the type of shop. On Sunday, opening times are later, typically around 11:00, and closing times vary from 14:00 - 22:00.

Some shops still observe a half-day closing on Wednesday and Saturday afternoons, and close on Sunday, although in most of the tourist areas of Cyprus, both shops and supermarkets stay open till late at night, and are also open on Sundays.

Electricity

In Cyprus the power plugs and sockets are of type G. The standard voltage is 240 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz
