Tuzla

Tuzla is a city and municipality in Bosnia and Herzegovina. At the time of the 2011 census, the municipality had 200,000 inhabitants. After Sarajevo, and Banja Luka, Tuzla is the third largest city in Bosnia and Herzegovina, and the seat of the Tuzla Canton and Tuzla Municipality. The name "Tuzla" is the Turkish word for salt mine, and refers to the extensive salt deposits found underneath the city. The city of Tuzla is home to Europe's only salt lake as part of its central park. One of the most influential writers in the Balkans, Meša Selimovic hails from Tuzla. The climate is moderate continental. The town was not spared the atrocities of the Bosnian War. On May 25, 1995, an attack on Tuzla killed 71 people, mostly children and injured 200 persons in Tuzla massacre when a shell hit the central street and its promenade. Several sports teams from Tuzla have participated in international competitions. Almost all of Tuzla's sports teams are named Sloboda, meaning freedom. The most popular sports in Tuzla include football (FK Sloboda); karate (KBS Tuzla-Sinbra) and many others. The women's basketball team Jedinstvo Aida were European club champions in the late eighties, with the most famous sports woman from Tuzla in their midst Razija Mujanovic. The first and oldest sport in Tuzla is gymnastics.

Sports Center Mejdan was built in 1984, at first for a great need to meet the needs of the citizens of Tuzla and the region in the area of physical culture, sport and culture, in creating the conditions for the stimulation and the improvement of modern sports shape and performance, cultural creativity, and different business events. The center is situated in the western part of the town and covers an area between the northern hillside of "Ilincica" and south freeway, opposite the transversal street to the Slatina block. The center is near an old Mejdan settlement, by which it was named after. Every day, the sports center is visited by 1,000 people - athletes, businessmen, citizens, and it is 30,000 a month and 360,000 a year which means that every citizen of Tuzla visits this beautiful building twice a year.

Citizens of the Arab Republic of Egypt are required visas when entering, exiting or travelling through Bosnia and Herzegovina.

LEBANON

Citizens of the Republic of Lebanon are required visas when entering, exiting or travelling through Bosnia and Herzegovina. Visa shall be issued in Amman, Jordan.

LIBYA

Citizens of the Libya are required visas when entering, exiting or travelling through Bosnia and Herzegovina.

MONACO

Citizens of the Principality of Monaco are exempted from the visa requirement when entering, exiting or travelling through Bosnia and Herzegovina.

MOROCCO

Citizens of the Kingdom of Morocco are required visas when entering, exiting or travelling through Bosnia and Herzegovina. Visa shall be issued in Madrid, Spain.

SYRIA

Citizens of the Syrian Arab Republic are required visas when entering, exiting or travelling through Bosnia and Herzegovina. Visa shall be issued in Amman, Jordan.

Citizens of the other countries are exempted from the visa requirement when entering, exiting or travelling through Bosnia and Herzegovina to 90 days.
