2. INTRODUCTION

The Mediterranean Karate Federation Union, also referred to as "MKFU", is a permanent organization with a legal status founded in the 3rd November 1986 and is composed of the official National Karate Federations of every Country in the Mediterranean basin affiliated to the Continental Unions of Africa, Asia and Europe. The MKFU is a member of the World Karate Federation - WKF and the International Committee of the Mediterranean Games - ICMG

The Mediterranean Karate Federations' Union Championships provide the opportunity for participants to aim for Olympic values, strive for excellence and personal development. The UFMK/MKFU has the aim of promoting, organizing, regulating and popularizing the sport of the Karate in every Country of the Mediterranean basin, of protecting the physical and mental health of the Athletes, of contributing to the development of friendly relations among the National Federations and of defending the interests of Karate throughout the world.

3. TUNIS , The capital of Tunisia



The city of Tunis is first of all its medina, one of the most beautiful in the world, listed as a World Heritage Site by Unesco, its mosques, its souk with narrow and colorful streets. But you can also reach pleasant beaches in less than half an hour, as well as discover the unmissable sites of the north coast: the village of Sidi Bou Saïd, justly renowned for its traditional architecture, its studded wooden doors and its charming Moorish cafes. You should also not miss visiting the ruins of Carthage for their setting and their first-rate cultural dimension.

Even if the medina of Tunis gives the impression of a real labyrinth, you can quickly find your way around thanks to the minaret of the Great Mosque (or Zitouna mosque) located in the center of the covered streets. The alleys and covered passages are ordered all around. We generally move forward following the flow of walkers, because the streets are quite narrow. But it is a pleasure to walk among the bags of spices, the displays of fabrics, the leather poufs and the ceramics. You will be tempted by many objects! To have a panoramic view of the old town, ask to access the terrace of one of the shops in the souk.

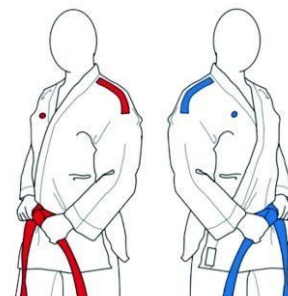

The registration starts two (2) months prior to the event, **10th March 2023**, and closes **on the 6th May 2023**.

Changes of online registration data are possible until the end of the online registration period.

6.2 Official Accreditation

The official registration session will take place on 19/5/2023

At registration, accreditation cards will be issued with the participants' main data, a photograph and information about registered categories. The accreditation card must be always worn during the event.

Only members of national federations recognized by WKF are admitted participating, following the registration procedures.

All participants must submit an official document (passport or other valid ID card) for the WKF identification and validation at the accreditation session.

The accreditation of any competitor must be done by the athlete or the athlete's coach, in person bringing the athlete passport or other valid ID at the accreditation session.

The competitor who has not collected, either personally or through his/her coach the accreditation during the official registration, will not be included in the draw.

The official weighing will take place during the registration session.

Each national federation can register FOUR (4) athletes and TWO (2) teams in each category.

Please note that all participants have to show their passports at the registration session.

Registration is €30 per athlete per category and €60 for each team.

-If changes are required during the official registration session, because of incorrect or missing registration data, a fee of € 20 is charged for each change

All payments must be processed at the registration to the treasurer of MKFU.

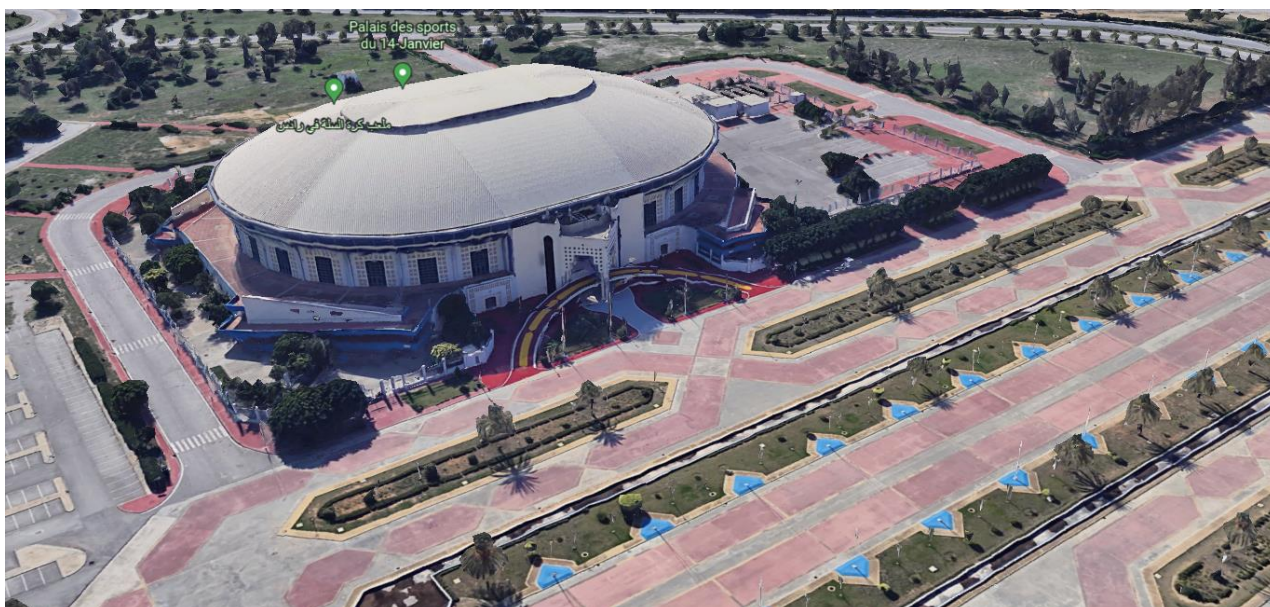

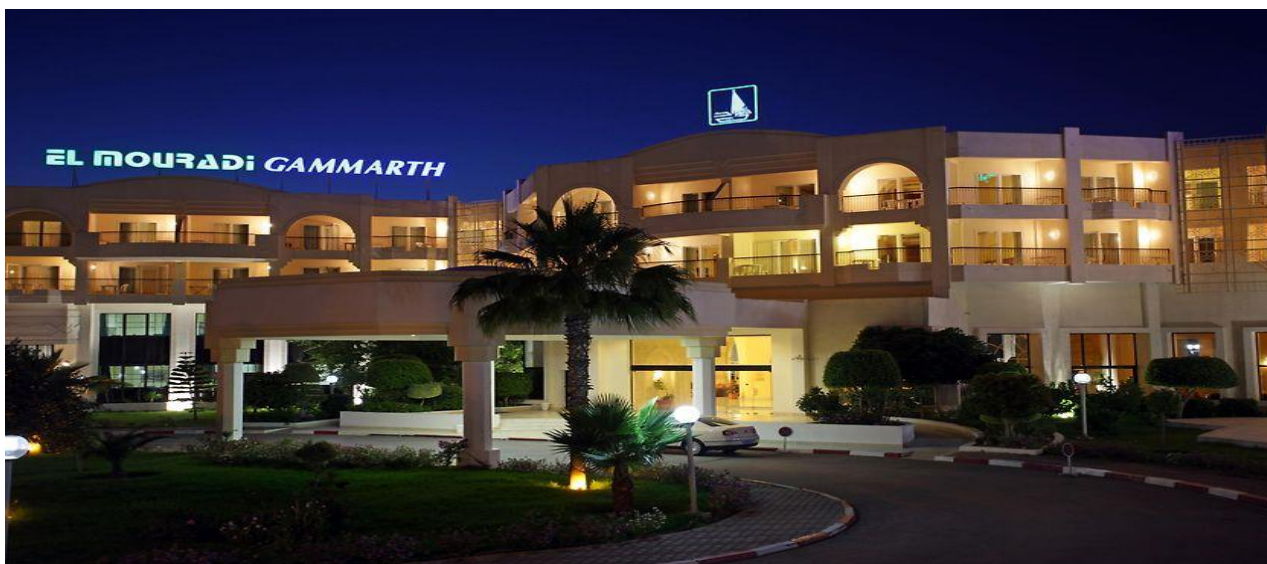
