The Mediterranean Karate Federation Union, also referred to as "MKFU", is a permanent organization with a legal status founded in the 3rd November 1986 and is composed of the official National Karate Federations of every Country in the Mediterranean basin affiliated to the Continental Unions of Africa, Asia and Europe. The MKFU is a member of the World Karate Federation - WKF and the International Committee of the Mediterranean Games - ICMG

The Mediterranean Karate Federations' Union Championships provide the opportunity for participants to aim for Olympic values, strive for excellence and personal development. The UFMK/MKFU has the aim of promoting, organizing, regulating and popularizing the sport of the Karate in every Country of the Mediterranean basin, of protecting the physical and mental health of the Athletes, of contributing to the development of friendly relations among the National Federations and of defending the interests of Karate throughout the world.


3. GUADALAJARA


Guadalajara is a Spanish city and municipality, capital of the province of the same name, in the autonomous community of Castilla-La Mancha. It is located on a hillock between two deep ravines, the Alamín and the Coquín or San Antonio, which brought their waters to the left bank of the Henares river valley, in the highest part of the southern plateau, between the regions of La Alcarria and La Campiña del Henares.

It was founded by the Arabs between the 8th and 9th centuries. Its name, from the Andalusian Arabic 'wād al-ḥaŷarah' (وادي الحجرة or واد الحجرة) given to the river Henares, is thought to have come from this period. Nearby there had been a Roman site, whose name, Arriaca, may have the same meaning. The city reached a certain splendour in the 10th century, despite its location in a territory that was almost always on a war footing

In 1085, Guadalajara was conquered by Alfonso VI of León, attributed to Alvar Fáñez de Minaya.5 From that moment until the battle of Navas de Tolosa in 1212, the history of the city reflects the course of the wars against the Almoravids and Almohads.6 In 1133, King Alfonso VII granted the first charter to the town to regulate the life of its community, establishing a set of rules, rights and privileges, and in 1219, Fernando III extended it by granting the long charter to the town.7 Subsequently, the protection of King Alfonso X ensured the economic development of the town, by defending its

merchants and authorising its fairs and markets. In the second half of the 14th century, the Mendoza family settled in Guadalajara, and their subsequent rise brought with it that of the city. In 1460, King Enrique IV granted the town the title of city. The 16th century saw a period of prosperity.







3.1 How to get to GUADALAJARA

Flight

The closest international airport from Guadalajara is Madrid Adolfo Suarez Madrid-Barajas.

- Madrid Airport is about 50Km away from GUADALAJARA.
- Madrid Airport is about 25Km away from ALCALÁ DE HENARES (town located 30 km from Guadalajara).

Train and bus

There is a frequency of train schedules between the following stations:



Online registration can be made under the following link. All Para Karate athletes registered shall be on the waiting list until confirmation of all necessary documentation.

During the registration procedure, upload all essential Para Karate Athlete's medical



documentation to the Sports ID Para Karate Athlete's profile.

The Head of Para Karate classification can ask for supplemental medical documentation to prove the underlying health condition of the athlete. The mandatory forms can be found at the following links:

To be considered eligible to compete as an athlete with an intellectual disability, athletes must fulfill the full eligibility criteria as defined by VIRTUS.

All documents MUST be attached in English for ALL registered athletes. All MDFs must be completed by a registered Medical Doctor, M.D.

All athletes must attend the classification session during registration time.

Please see the Para Karate registration checklist before the completion of the registration of the Para Karate athletes.

Para Karate Athletes per Category

Every nation has the opportunity to register three (3) Para-Athletes per sport class. In total, 24 athletes can be called by each nation.





Classification Session

Classification in Para Karate consists of extra point compensation in K10 and K30 sport classes depending on the influence of the particular impairment when performing the Kata. Detailed information can be found in the Para-Karate regulations:

Registered Para-Karate athletes must present themselves for a mandatory on- site Classification Session performed by qualified personnel before the championships.

The Classification Session will be performed during registration at the HQ Hotel.

For the classification of new athletes – those competing international championship for the first time – please ensure that their medical documentations are sent to: wkfparakarate@gmail.com

Attendance at the Classification Session is obligatory; without participation in such an event, it is not possible to take part in the championships.

The following documents have to be provided at the classification session:

- Accreditation of the athlete.
- ID card or Passport of the athlete.
- Original MDF as provided prior to the registration.
- Original diagnostic Report as described in the MDF for Intellectual Impairments as provided with the registration.

Coaches and Personal Assistant

A maximum of One (1) Coach can be registered for Para-Karate per Nation. Every Para-Karate athlete can be accompanied by a personal assistant during their performance on the field of play. This means One (1) personal assistant per Para Athlete.

Coach and assistants accompanying Para-Karate athletes MUST register together with their delegation at the onsite registration session only. All Para Athletes must use the same sportswear and equipment for classification as they use during the competitions.



Concerning athletes with visual impairments, no extra testing will be performed during the classification session. Nevertheless, the athletes have to show up to the classification with the documents and equipment mentioned above. Extra points will be given based on the Medical Diagnostic Form

Anti-Doping for Para-Karate

In compliance with WKF Anti-Doping Rules and WADA, Para-Karate athletes will be subjected to any eventual testing. If any Para-Karate athlete needs a Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE), please contact your National Anti-Doping Organization for further details and recognition. The duly recognized TUE at the national level will then have to be duly communicated to the WKF.

10. Official Accreditation

At registration, accreditation cards will be issued with the participants' main data, a photograph and information about registered categories. The accreditation card must be always worn during the event.

Only members of national federations recognized by WKF are admitted participating, following the registration procedures.

All participants must submit an official document (passport or other valid ID card) for the WKF identification and validation at the accreditation session.

The accreditation of any competitor must be done by the athlete or the athlete's coach, in person bringing the athlete passport or other valid ID at the accreditation session.

The competitor who has not collected, either personally or through his/her coach the accreditation during the official registration, will not be included in the draw.

The official weighing will take place during the registration session.

Each national federation can register FOUR (4) athletes and TWO (2) teams in each category.

Please note that all participants must show their passports at the registration session.

10.2 Entry Fee

- Registration is 50€ per athlete per category and 60€ for each team.
- 50€ for each referee participating in the referee seminar & exams
- Succeeding to the referee exams will receive a MKFU badge which is 30€ cost, and MKFU
 Tie which is 30€ cost.
- Annual country membership fee is 400€ and must be paid during the registration to MKFU treasurer.
- If changes are required during the official registration session, because of incorrect or missing registration data, a fee of 20€ is charged for each change
