The MKFU is a member of the World Karate Federation - WKF and the International Committee of the Mediterranean Games - ICMG

The Mediterranean Karate Federations' Union Championships provide the opportunity for participants to aim for Olympic values, strive for excellence and personal development. The UFMK/MKFU has the aim of promoting, organizing, regulating and popularizing the sport of the Karate in every Country of the Mediterranean basin, of protecting the physical and mental health of the Athletes, of contributing to the development of friendly relations among the National Federations and of defending the interests of Karate throughout the world.

3. ALEXANDRIA

Also, frequency Super Jet buses from Cairo International Airport to Alexandria City. The time in the bus is around 3 hours.

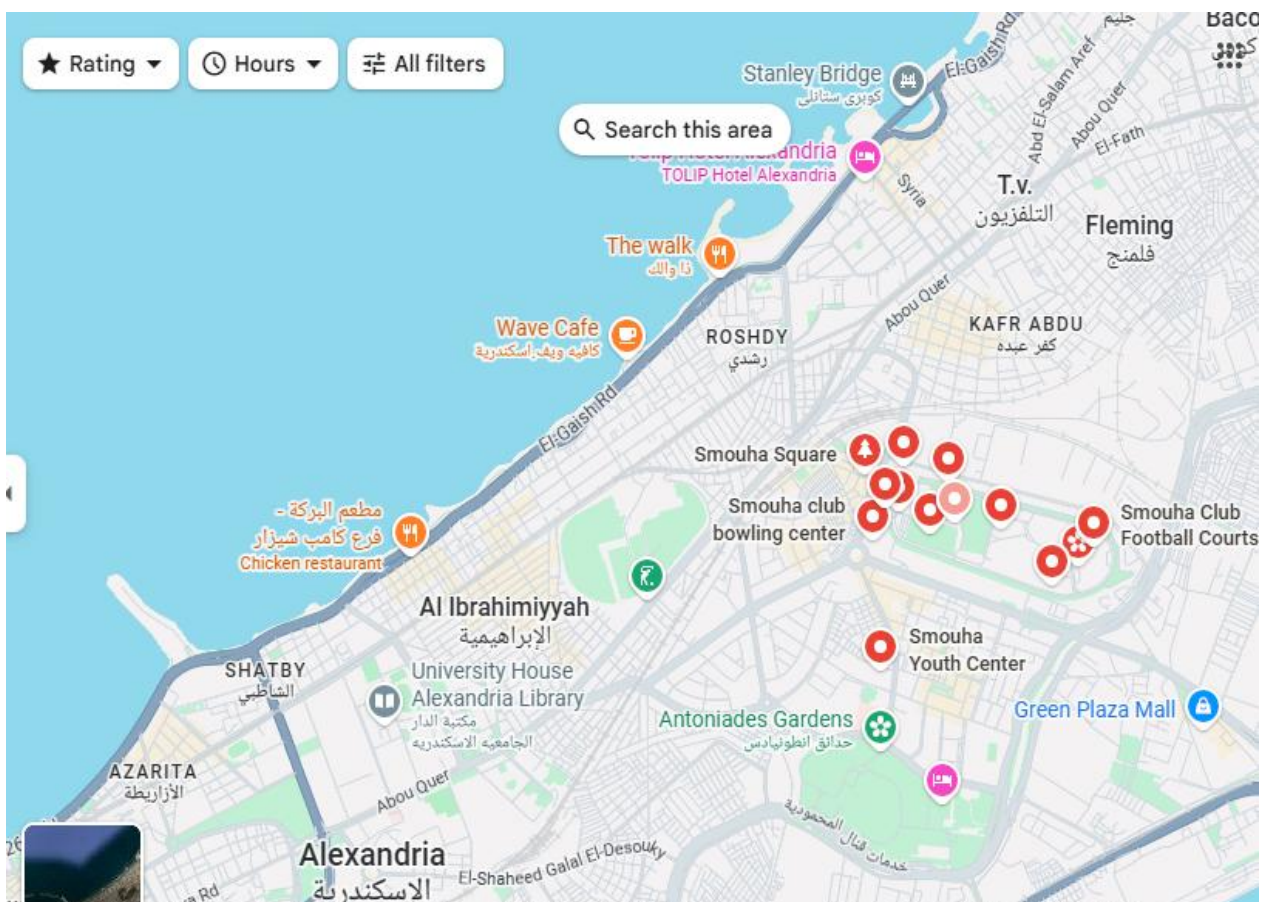
For Borg El Arab Airport: There is a frequency Buses from the Airport to Alexandria City.

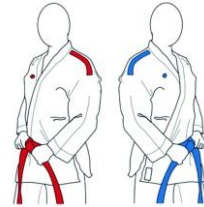

10. Official Accreditation

At registration, accreditation cards will be issued with the participants' main data, a photograph and information about registered categories. The accreditation card must be always worn during the event.

Only members of national federations recognized by WKF are admitted participating, following the registration procedures.

All participants must submit an official document (passport or other valid ID card) for the WKF identification and validation at the accreditation session.

The accreditation of any competitor must be done by the athlete or the athlete's coach, in person bringing the athlete passport or other valid ID at the accreditation session.

The competitor who has not collected, either personally or through his/her coach the accreditation during the official registration, will not be included in the draw.

The official weighing will take place during the registration session.

Each national federation can register FOUR (4) athletes and TWO (2) teams in each category.

Please note that all participants must show their passports at the registration session.

10.2 Entry Fee

- Registration is 50€ per athlete per category for individual, and 60€ for each team.
- 50€ for each referee participating in the referee seminar & exams
- Succeeding to the referee exams will receive a MKFU badge which is 30€ cost, and MKFU Tie which is 30€ cost.
- Annual country membership fee for year 2026 is 400€ and must be paid before or during the registration to MKFU General Treasurer.
- If changes are required during the official registration session, because of incorrect or missing registration data, a fee of 20€ is charged for each change
